

Recently a police force was reported to have rushed onto a crime scene in which there were people being held hostage. But not be mad at anyone but himself due to the fact the small town law enforcement department didn't have a tactical unit their haste to resolve the situation ended up in the unnecessary deaths of two hostages. Listen, what we know about also knew that potential was nothing if it a situation doesn't give us the clearance to approach it without great tact and great tactics.
